Inspired by Christ's Seven Last Words, I Call Your Name is a seven-movement choral cycle for choir, soprano soloist, string quartet, and percussion. The text touches on Christ's last words from the cross as recorded in the New Testament Gospels. The work compares Christ's suffering to that of our own both in a sacred and secular sense. Poet and librettist, Brian Newhouse, penned each movement as a reaction to or meditation on the seven last words. Transcendent themes of forgiveness, need, fear, and our hope for peace are made intimate by the first-person text. This is a very human seven last words.
