Contemporary English composer and conductor Sir John Rutter is best known for his large body of Christmas carol arrangements and sacred choral music. Lesser known are Rutter's instrumental works including several pieces for solo organ. The postlude for this morning's service is a jubilant new take on the traditional organ toccata. Written in septuple meter (seven beats per measure), the unusual rhythmic pattern provides the work with a fresh energy somewhat reminiscent of Dave Brubeck's jazz classic *Take Five*.
